
EXAMPLE PATHS TO 60 PDCs TRACK YOUR PDCs IN YOUR SHRM CERTIFICATION PORTAL



THE ROAD TO SHRM RECERTIFICATION

Maintain Your Credential

The SHRM recertification process is about more than just renewing your credential. It's a way to up your game and take your professional expertise to the next level.

There are two ways to recertify:

Earn 60 professional development credits (PDCs) within your three-year recertification cycle. Or retake the SHRM certification exam.

You must complete one of these options by your recertification end date (the last day of your birth month, three years after you earn SHRM certification).

TRACK

Log your professional development activities in your SHRM Certification Portal.

Log in to your SHRM **Certification Portal at**

portal.shrm.org

Click "Add PDCs," and then choose the related PDC category:

- Advance Your Education
- Advance Your Organization
- Advance Your Profession

Add your activities.



Submit your completed recertification application as early as one year into your recertification cycle.

Recertify early and begin earning for the next cycle right away.

60 PDCs are all you need, but if you earn more, carry-over up to 20 additional credits to your new cycle.

Can't complete the process by your end date?

Take advantage of the 60-day grace period to get it done.

Create and present a course based on HR-related competencies and/or knowledge domains. **1-20 PDCs**

RESEARCH. WRITING AND PUBLISHING

Conduct primary research on an HR-related competency or knowledge domain and publish that research, and/or write a book, article, white paper or blog post (published by a third party).

Up to 30 PDCs

VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES

Perform HR-related duties free of charge for an HR association, membership organization or other nonprofit.

PROFESSIONAL MEMBERSHIP

Earn credit by being a SHRM national member or a member of a SHRM affiliate organization.
